4. COLLABORATION

7. INVITATION TO HEARING

You will be invited to attend a hearing, along with your RMA.



8. SUBMISSION

Your RMA will prepare a legal submission outlining the arguments of your case, which will be accompanied by documentary evidences.



9. AAT HEARING

You & your RMA will attend a hearing (either via video or in person), where your case and arguments will be heard.



11. DECISION & ARCHIVE DOHA

The decision will be received by the Dept of Home Affairs and you will be notified. The file will be closed and archived for 7 years. Any original documents to be sent back to you.



10. DECISION FROM AAT

Within 14 days of the hearing, your decision will be received. If the decision is remitted, the application will be sent back to DOHA for a new decision.
